FAIRY FLOSS MACHINE-OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Put the bowl over the top making sure that you line up the tabs with latches (Figure 1).
- 2. The Power switch starts the head spinning and the Controller controls the heat (Figure 2).
- 3. When starting the machine, turn the Power and the Controller heat on full and allow the machine to warm up for about 3 to 5 minutes (no longer or may overheat). Once at maximum temperature, turn the dial down to about half way.
- 4. Turn the machine off before pouring mixture into machine.
- 5. Pour a small amount of Floss Mixture into the machine (about 2 tablespoons) centre and then turn machine back on again using Power button (Figure 3).
- 6. Using a twisting motion with the stick, sweep around the edge of the bowl to collect the Fairy Floss on the stick.
- 7. Keep going until you get a 10 centimetre ball of floss on the stick (Figure 4).
- 8. The machine needs more mixture when the machine stops producing Fairy Floss.
- 9. When you are finished making the Fairy Floss turn down the Controller (heat) and leave the head spinning for about 5 minutes to cool the machine down before you turn off the Power.

Handy Hints!

- Only use 2 Tablespoons of floss mixture at a time, create one floss stick and then refill the machine to make the next one.
- Humidity/moisture in the air affects the Fairy Floss. The Fairy Floss begins to melt and it will shrink. The Fairy Floss crystallises very quickly.

Troubleshooting

- The Power switch must be on and the heat controller must be turned up to produce fairy floss.
- Don't overload the machine with too much Floss Mixture.
- Make sure the machine is heated up before adding the mixture.
- If you've overloaded the machine, turn the power off and carefully with two people tip the machine upside down to empty out the excess mixture.
- Fairy Floss won't come out. Have you allowed enough time for the machine to heat up before you added the floss mixture (see step 3).
- Fairy floss coming out too fast. Turn the Controller (heat) down slightly. The amount of floss that cone controlled by the heat.
- Let the machine run for at least 10 minutes and fairy floss should start coming out if you have overloaded the more run.
